

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF JEFFERSON PARK HISTORIC
LANDMARK ZONING DISTRICT**

The following described property has been designated as part of the Historic Landmark ("HL") District, an overlay zoning district commonly called Jefferson Park HL District, pursuant to the terms of Ordinance No. 21,162, adopted by the City Council of The City of Oklahoma City on November 3, 1998.

Jefferson Park HL Zoning District:

Lots 15 – 17 inclusive, Block 1; Lots 1 – 3 inclusive, the north 5 feet of Lot 4, and Lots 11 – 14 inclusive, Block 2; Lots 1 and 2, and Lots 15 – 22 inclusive, Block 4; All of Blocks 5 – 7 inclusive; Lots 8 – 24 inclusive, and the west 45 feet of Lot 25, Block 8; Lots 9 – 22 inclusive, Block 9; Lots 7 – 10 inclusive, Block 10; All of Blocks 11 – 13 inclusive; Lots 9 – 11 inclusive, Block 14; Lots 9 – 22 inclusive, Block 16; All of Blocks 19, 20, and 25 of Jefferson Park Addition; and

Lots 1 – 8 inclusive, Block 3 of an amended plat of Jefferson Park Addition (June 1909); and all of the July 1909 amended plat of Jefferson Park Addition (Blocks 15, 17, 18, 21, 22, 23, 24, parts of Blocks 10 and 14, and Goodholm Park and Sparrow Park); and


Lots 7 – 20 inclusive, Block 26; Lots 8 – 21 inclusive, Block 27; and Lots 9 – 22 inclusive, Block 28 of Jefferson Park Second Addition.

Properties within the Historic Landmark District are subject to the Historic Preservation Regulations set forth in Section 59-4200, *et seq.*, of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2002, as amended.

Compliance with the Historic Landmark District Regulations includes, but is not limited to, the requirement to obtain a Certificate of Appropriateness prior to the erection, moving, demolition, reconstruction, restoration, or alteration of any structure, excluding interior work, unless specifically exempted by said Historic Preservation Regulations.

Failure to comply with the HL District Regulations is a violation of City Ordinances and may result in the issuance of Notice(s) of Violation, and/or Citation(s) to the property owner and/or occupant.
