Dear Real Estate Professional,

The City Council of Oklahoma City has recently adopted a Resolution to aid in our effort to increase the awareness of Historic Preservation Regulations among owners and new purchasers of property within Historic Preservation and Historic Landmark Zoning Districts.

Attached you will find a copy of the Council Resolution along with a memorandum to the Mayor and City Council that includes a brief background and purpose of the Resolution. We are forwarding this information with a request that you help us ensure the Public Notices are passed along in listing and sales information for property located within the Historic Districts.

To facilitate the Public Notice disclosure to your clients, each Notice has been filed with the Oklahoma County Registrar of Deeds and clearly shows the applicable Document Number along with the Book & Page location. The Notices contain the legal description of all properties located within each specific Historic Neighborhood.

It is the City's earnest desire that all new owners of property affected by the Historic Preservation Regulations have a maximum opportunity to be notified of the responsibilities of Historic property ownership. We appreciate your assistance in this process.
